Our Annual Summer Party will take place on **11 September** and we will be sending out letters of invitation soon.

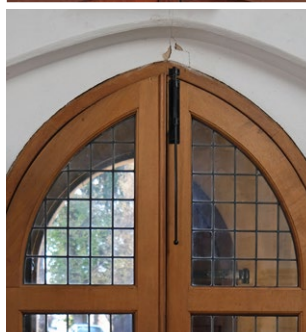


## 2025 Project
