This manages direct debit giving to the church and allows donors to give regularly and securely, to increase their donation annually according to inflation if they wish, and to give anonymously. It also reduces our bank charges and collects Gift Aid automatically. 40, slightly more than half of our regular givers, now give in this way and we would love to have more.
